

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
STANDING BOARD OF ELECTIONS**

May 16, 2020

4:40 P.M.

Mr. Rick Peterson called the Standing Board of Election meeting to order at 4:40 p.m. with the following present: Pastor Isaac Ross and Virginia Hastings. City Clerk, Tracy Torbert, City Manager Charles Anderson and Director of Economic Development and Community Relations, Trisha Newcomer were also present.

New Business #1: Certification of the 2020 City of Seaford Municipal Election results.

Election Judge Peterson read the Certification of Election. The total number of ballots cased was 594 with includes 350 absentee ballots. For Mayor which is a two-year term, David Genshaw received 317 votes and James King received 270 votes. David Genshaw will serve as the Mayor for the next two years.

For City Council, there were two seats up for election for a three-year term. Alan Cranston received 289 votes, Dan H Henderson received 374 votes and Jose Santos received 376 votes. Dan H Henderson and Jose Santos will serve on the City Council for the next three years.

Election Judge Peterson called for a motion to close the Standing Board of Elections Meeting. Mrs. Hastings made a motion to close the Standing Board of Elections. Pastor Ross seconded the motion. Election Judge Peterson called for a Roll Call Vote:

Mr. Peterson voted yes;

Mrs. Hastings voted yes;

Pastor Ross voted yes.

The motion so passed with all voting in favor. The Standing Board of Elections was closed at 4:50 p.m.
