

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE  
ANNEXATION COMMITTEE

September 24, 2018

Chairman Vice-Mayor Dan Henderson called the meeting to order with the following people present: Councilman H. William Mulvaney, Councilwoman Leanne Phillips-Lowe, Charles Anderson, City Manager and Trisha Newcomer, Director of Economic Development.

Vice-Mayor Henderson stated that there was no New Business to discuss today.

He then moved to Old Business which was to discuss the annexation committee report and letter received from Seaford Nylon Employee Council Board of Trustees. City Manager Anderson stated that a letter was provided stating that Mr. Melson does have the power to execute the petition and request annexation on behalf of the Seaford Nylon Employee Council. He added that the City Solicitor, Dan Griffith has reviewed the letter and agreed that it is sufficient authorization.
