



## Mayor's Right Choice Award

Mayor David Genshaw is pleased to continue the award program to recognize a Seaford community high school senior who has made the right choices in life.

### **Purpose**

The primary purpose of the Mayor's Right Choice Award is to honor a Seaford community senior who, by making the right choices in life, has exhibited a positive influence on the Seaford community. The award is not intended to acknowledge academic achievements, but rather to recognize the student as a role model. It is the hope that this program which rewards students who make the right choices will encourage other youth to aspire to also make the right choices in life.

The Right Choice Award will be comprised of an engraved plaque and \$500.

### **Guidelines:**

1. Applicant **must** reside within the Seaford School District and be eligible for graduation.
2. Applications must be submitted on the attached information form, along with the **required** essay. Incomplete submissions will be disqualified.
3. A typed essay, no more than one page in length, must be submitted. It should emphasize the applicant's personal contributions to the City of Seaford and why they deem themselves deserving of the Mayor's Right Choice Award. These contributions may include, but are not limited to: community service projects, school activities, neighborhood organization involvement, church activities, or other volunteer projects.
4. Applicant shall have demonstrated a commitment to improving the quality of school and community life and exemplified him/herself as a role model for living a drug free life. Please be specific - remember that this is the information on which the judges will base their decision.
5. Awards will not be made in recognition of a single event or effort.

### **Review Process:**

1. Completed applications must be received at City Hall by close of business at 5 p.m. on May 21, 2021.
2. The Mayor's Right Choice Committee will review applications in accordance with criteria and guidelines above.
3. The committee reserves the right to interview the nominee and request additional information.
4. The award will be presented at the regular meeting of Mayor and Council on June 8, 2021 (unless other arrangements are made).
