

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF ELECTIONS**

April 17, 2021

Mr. H. William Mulvaney called the Board of Election meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Matthew C. Read, George F. Stewart, Cynthia Cummings and Stacie Spicer. City Clerk, Tracy Torbert and Director of Economic Development and Community Relations, Trisha Newcomer were also present.

New Business #1: Conduct the process to open and tally absentee ballots for the 2021 Municipal Election.

City Clerk Torbert reported that there were 47 absentee ballots requested. All requests were confirmed to be eligible and registered voters. All 47 absentee ballots have been returned to the office. A list of the voters that voted by absentee ballot was provided on the livestream screen for the public's view. There were no candidate challengers present to provide a list of absentee voters to at this time.

Chairman Mulvaney asked Mrs. Spicer and Ms. Cummings to open the absentee ballots for him to read aloud while Mr. Stewart and Mr. Read tallied the votes.

After opening the ballots, Mr. Stewart and Mr. Read confirmed their tallies matched.

Chairman Mulvaney called for a motion to close the Board of Elections Meeting. Mr. Stewart made a motion to close the Board of Elections. Mr. Read seconded the motion.

The motion so passed with all voting in favor. The Board of Elections was closed at 1:45 p.m.
