The Seaford Police Department is proposing an increase to the fee charged for fingerprinting.

Currently, and for the past 15 plus years, the fee charged by Seaford Police Department is \$5.00 per card and is not in line with what Delaware State Police charges. Municipal departments in Sussex County do not offer this service any longer.

I propose to increase the rate to \$25.00/per 2-card set. When you consider that an officer must be pulled from the road and spends at least 20 minutes performing this task, it more than justifies the cost.
