MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE CITY OF SEAFORD BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS

Mayor David Genshaw called the meeting to order with City Solicitor, Daniel Griffith and Mike Bailey, Building Official, present.

The property is located on the east side of Sussex Highway, Address: 22899 Sussex Hwy., Zoning District: C-2. Tax Map and Parcel # 331-6.00-4.01.

Mr. Bailey stated that the requested variance is to accommodate the seasonal garden center to be located in the parking lot. Mr. Bailey also stated that, Joseph Lough, Manager at Walmart was present to answer any questions from the members or public.

Mayor Genshaw solicited any questions from the members; there was no one from the public present.

City Solicitor, Daniel Griffith, asked about the length of time in which the Garden Center in the parking lot is open.

Mr. Lough stated a few months. Typically the Garden Center runs from April until the end of June, beginning of July.

City Solicitor Griffith made a motion to approve the variance request from Section 15-75 (9) of the City of Seaford Zoning Ordinance, stating that through past history and experience with the referenced request, with there being no negative feedback, he sees no issues with approving the requested variance.
