Application for Memorial Bricks

The Veteran's Committee of Seaford, consisting of the American Legion Post 6 & 37, the Am Vets Post #1694 the Disabled American Veterans Chapter 9, the Marine Corps League Detachment 780 and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #4961, in conjunction with the Kiwanis Club of Seaford and the City of Seaford have established a Veterans Walk of bricks to be installed in the Kiwanis Memorial Park around the Memorial Monument for the Purpose of recognizing those who have survived wars or conflicts and those who have served. This walk will run from the sidewalk next to Stein Highway to the street on the south side of the park across and in front of the Memorial Monument. The bricks will be installed twice a year (just prior to Memorial Day and Veterans Day).

A Committee has been established, from members of the above listed organizations, to screen applications. The Memorial Monument and Veterans Walk Fund of the City of Seaford is a receivership account of the monies to be used for the project. the cost of the bricks to you is \$45.00 per brick (\$20.00 will be used for the installation of the bricks, maintenance of the flagpoles and the Memorial and Veterans Walk).

If interested in a brick, please fill out the attached application and documented eligibility attached to application: enclose a check payable to Seaford Veterans Committee (MEMO: Veterans Walk) and mail to Seaford Veterans Committee, P.O. Box 781, Seaford, DE 19973, Do Not mail originals of eligibity forms (i.e. DD-214 or Honorable Discharge as these will not be returned to you). SEAFORD MEMORIAL WALK OF BRICKS APPLICATION

ELIGIBLITY REQUIREMENTS

If you are, or have been, a resident of the Seaford School District for one year, or a member of a local Veterans organization, you or your relatives that meet eligibility requirements may apply for this program

The Committee has decided by vote to not accept those who are still serving as their status may change, they prefer an Honorable Separation from the Military Service. Applications received prior to April 1st will be processed, installed and dedicated at the Memorial Day services, and applications received prior to Sept. 1st will be processed, installed and dedicated at the Veterans Day services.

VERIFICATION OF SERVICE: it is imperative that you be able to verify the service time of the applicant by a **COPY** of their **HONORABLE** discharge papers. **PLEASE SEND COPIES ONLY**, as they will be kept in strictest confidence, after a register of names and dates these copies will be destroyed for the safety and security of all involved. Verification may be made in the form of an Honorable Discharge, a **DD214**, Separation papers, Current or pervious Proof of Membership in a veterans Organization, or a picture of a Government issued grave marker, or as established by the Department of Defense.

There may be Three (3) line of engraving, with and maximum of 14 characters per line including spaces. The letters "M and/or W" count for 1½ space. Please use the Ampersand (&) in place of "AND" whenever possible. Please note that anything outside the normal perimeters can be done, Towers Signs, LLC reserves the right to layout the bricks so it can be blasted and easily read. If the 1st line is longer than 14 characters we will adjust the font to insure the name of the Service person is on one line as shown below. For more than one war or unit served you may need to purchase additional brick. This is a sample of what your bricks may look like.
